How does your state use the API process?	NV utilizes the APPC interface between our mainframe and the Oracle servers and then creating XML for the APIs. The interfaces are with our UI, Re-employment, state specific program (CEP), IVRU and with LWIB systems.

The following staff maintains and supports AOSOS, but not 100% of their time. 3 liaison user staff for administration (includes participation in the AOSOS Scope and Steering Committees), 2 help desk staff, 2 Oracle DBA's, 1 Oracle Discoverer reporting tool administrator, 1 API gateway interface programmer, 2 AOSOS application programmers and 1 applications team lead staff.
