	in lieu of the remediation effort required to bring our ES legacy into Y2K
	compliance. With the need to implement the WIA legislation approaching,
	however, we became aware that we needed a One-Stop system rather than a
	new ES system. The original decision was based on the availability of the
	federally supported America's One-Stop Operating system (AOSOS) as the
	most cost efficient way to obtain a One-Stop system.
